## PCY 1003 General Psychology (3 Units)

A survey of psychology as an empirical/behavioral science. Topics include biological correlates of behavior, learning, cognition, emotion, motivation, personality, assessment, development, psychopathology, psychotherapy, and social psychology. Letter grade.

Also offered as PSY 1003.

## PCY 3008 Developmental Psychology - Birth Through Adolescence (4 Units)

A systematic study of the physical, cognitive, social, and emotional development of the individual from birth through adolescence.

## PCY 3021 Abnormal Psychology (3 Units)

Study of etiology, assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of various forms of abnormal behavior from various psychological perspectives. Letter grade.

**Prerequisite(s):** One of: FCS 1050, PCY 1003, PCY 3008, or consent of instructor.
